Overview: Society calls them “at-risk,” “delinquent,” or “troubled.” At Campagna Academy, we have always called them by name. Founded over 60 years ago as Hoosier Boys’ Town, Campagna Academy today restores the hopes and dreams of over 350 youths and families per year. We are a 501c3, non-profit, social services agency licensed by the Indiana Department of Child Services and are one of only two agencies in Northwest Indiana who is accredited by the Council on Accreditation of Services for Families and Children, Inc (COA). Campagna Academy’s life-changing programs strengthen and reunite families, giving young men and women the opportunity to make positive life changes that lead to social responsibility and personal success.

Why Campagna Academy? Campagna Academy is a mission-centered, vision-inspired, “for-impact” organization that works to change the world one youth at a time. Our full continuum of care is designed to meet the needs of the individual, providing educational, therapeutic, psycho-educational, vocational, and independent living programs. When you send your client to Campagna Academy, you can trust that they will receive the highest quality of care. We were awarded the 2007 Great Lake Award for best non-profit management, but also because of our standard programs that include:

- Masters level clinicians
- Fully licensed and accredited teachers and Charter School
- Step-down residential living
- Outcome-based “phase system” treatment model

- Extensive recreational amenities including 40 wooded acres with pond, weight room with nautilus equipment, soccer, baseball, and football fields, and an indoor recreational center

Clients Served: Campagna Academy is licensed to serve children ages 6 to 21 (our typical client falls into the 11 to 18 age range) who struggle with emotional, behavioral, or educational problems and issues of abandonment, abuse, neglect, persistent truancy, depression, delinquency, substance abuse, and/or severe familial conflict.

Programs Offered:

PSYCHIATRIC RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT FACILITY (PRTF)

Our Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facility (PRTF), located in the Hope Center is a secure facility for males and females in need of intensive therapeutic treatment. Our PRTF has room for 48 kids that typically fall in the 12-18 age range. PRTF is designed to serve youth with severe emotional, behavioral, and psychological problems that need a highly structured therapeutic environment. Children often come to us suffering from stress, aggression towards themselves or others, anxiety and defiant behavior. Our PRTF is designed to help the child step down to a less structured treatment plan. Families with Indiana Medicaid can now refer their children for treatment.

PRIVATE SECURE RESIDENTIAL: Campagna Academy is proud to offer private secure care for young men and women with its 48 bed residence. This state-of-the-art treatment facility resembles an on-campus dorm and includes four on-site classrooms, computer lab, family visitation rooms, fitness center, and therapists’ offices. Campagna Academy provides treatment with individual, family and group therapy, individualized on-site education, social skills and anger management training, plus other psycho-educational programs. Residents receive psychiatric services as needed and are continually reassessed for readiness to move to less restrictive living.

OPEN RESIDENTIAL CARE: For over 60 years, open residential programs have been at the heart of what we do. Our life-changing services include: MA level therapists, individualized strength-based treatment plans, step-down living arrangements, individual and family therapy, psycho-educational groups, substance abuse treatment, vocational assessment, independent living skills, on-campus employment, off-campus employment, psychiatric services, and therapeutic recreational programs.

THERAPEUTIC DAY TREATMENT: Our program is designed for youth with behavioral or emotional problems who have been unable to maintain stability in the home, school or community setting. Designed to treat the needs of the whole person, our treatment will address psychiatric needs, individual, group and family therapy; educational needs, vocational needs/independent living needs and even provides door to door transportation. Our treatment team consists of licensed teachers, licensed therapists, case managers, nursing staff, psychiatrist, psychologist, and youth care specialists. Our goal is to help improve the child's functioning, while allowing for the child to remain in the home – without institutionalization.

INTENSIVE HOME & COMMUNITY BASED SERVICES: Campagna Academy's Intensive Home Based and Community Based Services are designed for youth with behavioral or emotional problems that have begun to transition out of a more secured placement and back into their home/community. These services assist with increasing stability or success in the home, school, and community while preventing a return of youth to a more restrictive setting/placement.

EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMING: Flexibility and diversification describe Campagna Academy's approach to education. Our educational programs are targeted to each client's specific need. Campagna Academy will work with your client's community public school when appropriate, or will provide on-campus regular or special education (multi-categorical) classrooms. Campagna's educational offerings also include a daytime GED program, an on-campus Charter school, and tutoring. All educational programs include individualized, strength-based, academic instruction consistent with the student's academic ability and achievement. Licensed and accredited teachers develop individualized education plans that enable students to participate in I-STEP testing and earn Core 40 credits toward their high school diploma. Written progress reports and court reports provided.

FOSTER CARE: As a part of our full continuum of care, Campagna Academy employs a full-time Family Support Team (FST) custom tailored for each child. Family concept is taught through experienced and appropriate role models. Individualized solution-focused therapy services are provided by a licensed, MA level therapist. Services include intensive case management, family counseling, IDL skills, respite care, 24 hour crisis intervention, family reunification, and aftercare services. Treatment goal is permanency.
