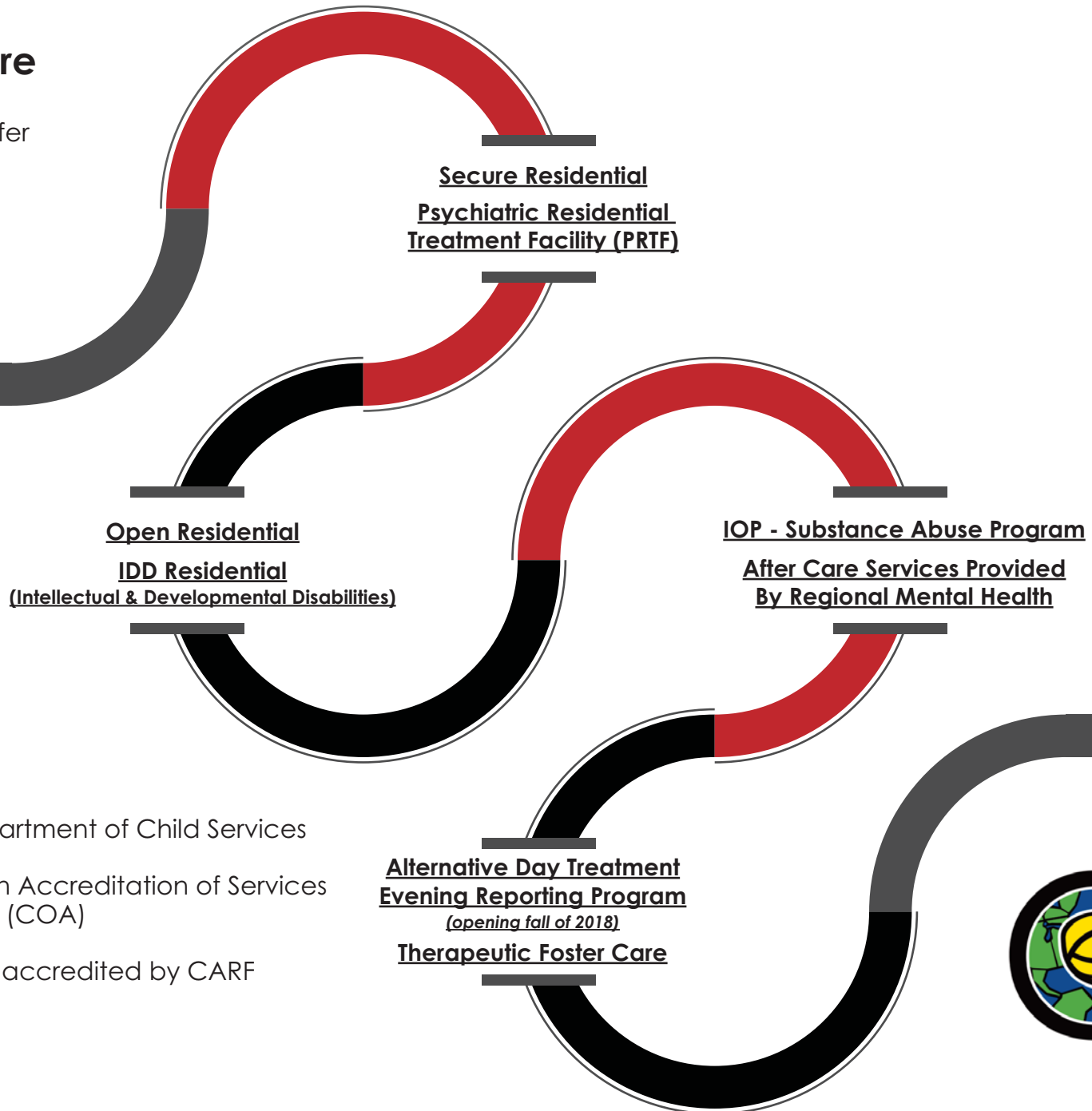

Shavonne Dennie has been a foster parent for 15 years. She became a foster parent because... "I was working at the Marion Home for Pregnant Teens, as I left the job I kept in touch with my girls. A young lady called me up a few months later and shared she was having a difficult time in the foster home she resided in. She asked me to become a foster parent. I become a foster parent with a 16 year old and her newborn son at the age of 25. There have been ups and downs..tears and joys but my favorite part about being a foster parent is being a blessing to children, introducing many of them to church and providing a safe, nurturing loving environment until they can return home or gain permanency. I believe that being a foster parenting is not a job or duty but a calling".

Horseshoe Casino Hammond selected Campagna Academy to be the recipient of their 2017 Hero Volunteer Project. Caesars Foundation donated \$10,000 to fund the volunteer project at Campagna Academy.

Nearly fifty volunteers from Horseshoe Casino embarked on a two day renovation project in one of our residential cottages that serves boys with intellectual and developmental disabilities. They volunteered their time and talents to remodel the kitchen and bathroom with new countertops, cabinets and fresh paint. Our client's bedrooms also received new vinyl window coverings and handmade closet coverings. The volunteers also deep cleaned the carpet in the entire cottage. The exterior of two of our residential cottages got a makeover with a landscaping project that included new plants, flowers, and mulch.

Elena Dwyre, Campagna Academy's CEO shared, "We are delighted to have been chosen by Horseshoe Casino for their Caesars Foundation donation. We were in desperate need of assistance to help renovate our cottages, which some are 50 years old or older. The level of dedication from each and every one of the employees from Horseshoe was clearly seen every day, regardless of the warm weather, and amount of work needed. They all had smiles on their faces and truly wanted to be here and make a difference. On behalf of myself, our Board of Directors and the children at Campagna, we thank Horseshoe Casino for their generosity!"

In addition to the work on the residential cottages Horseshoe volunteers converted a vacant space in the Campagna Center into a Bedroom Décor Store for our residents. This décor store will allow our residents to select their own bedspread, decorative pillows, rugs and room posters making their rooms feel a little more like home. Horseshoe's carpenters custom built floor to ceiling shelves just for the decor store. The shelves of the décor store were stocked by Horseshoe employees that hosted a donation drive at the casino for employees that could not volunteer on Campagna Academy's campus.

"While we know that monetary support is always beneficial, it is just as important for our volunteers to be able to put their talents to work in our community. One of the wall quotes we selected for the décor store says, 'Don't look back - you're not heading that way anyway.' We want the young people at Campagna to remember that quote as they seek to find their own path in life. Horseshoe is extremely proud to be able to work with the amazing Campagna team to make the lives of the at-risk youth in our community one of hope," said Dawn Reynolds Pettit, Horseshoe's Regional Vice President of Human Resources.





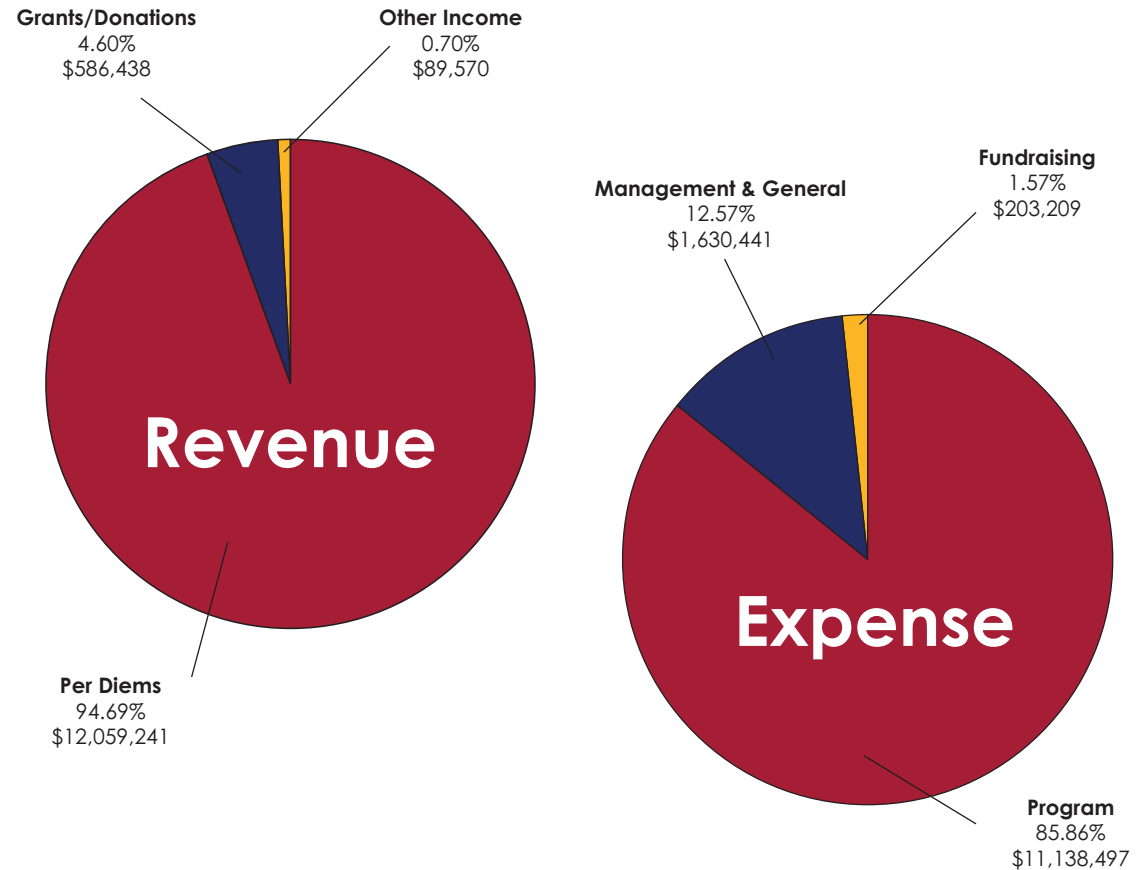
Looking Forward

Brian Harrell is a 2005 Campagna Academy alumnus who had returned to Northwest Indiana to share his remarkable story with the youth of Campagna and the supporters of Campagna Academy for our 70th Anniversary Celebration.

Brian was born in Harvey, Illinois and grew up in Gary, IN where he says he did not know his biological parents and was placed immediately into foster care. Harrell says, "I followed a path of destruction and saw no other alternative for my future." In the Fall of 2002, at the age of 14, Brian came to Campagna and that all changed. Brian was a resident in our open residential program until the Spring of 2005 when he earned his GED and was accepted to Vincennes University. In 2006, Brian joined the United States Army and was promoted to Sergeant E-5, just 3 years later. He served in both Iraq and Afghanistan and was honorably discharged in July 2012. In December 2015, Brian earned his A.A.S in Business from Ivy Tech Community College. Brian has recently accepted a position in Nashville, TN that allows him to be closer to his daughter, Amira, who was born in 2010.

Brian shared, "What Campagna is doing for our youth goes beyond their mission statement. This organization is showing the youth the gap between Restoring Hope and Building Dreams. While I was there, the staff reminded me that the road did not have to end there." After hearing his story, Brian's hope is that the youth of Campagna take with them the mindset of always putting others before themselves and the knowledge that "who you are today does not have to dictate who you will be tomorrow."
