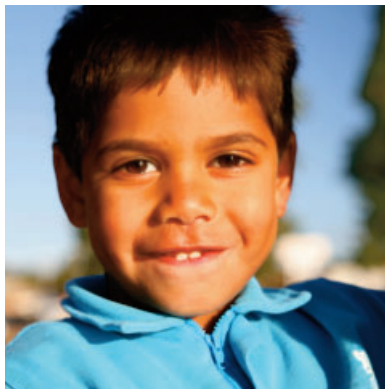

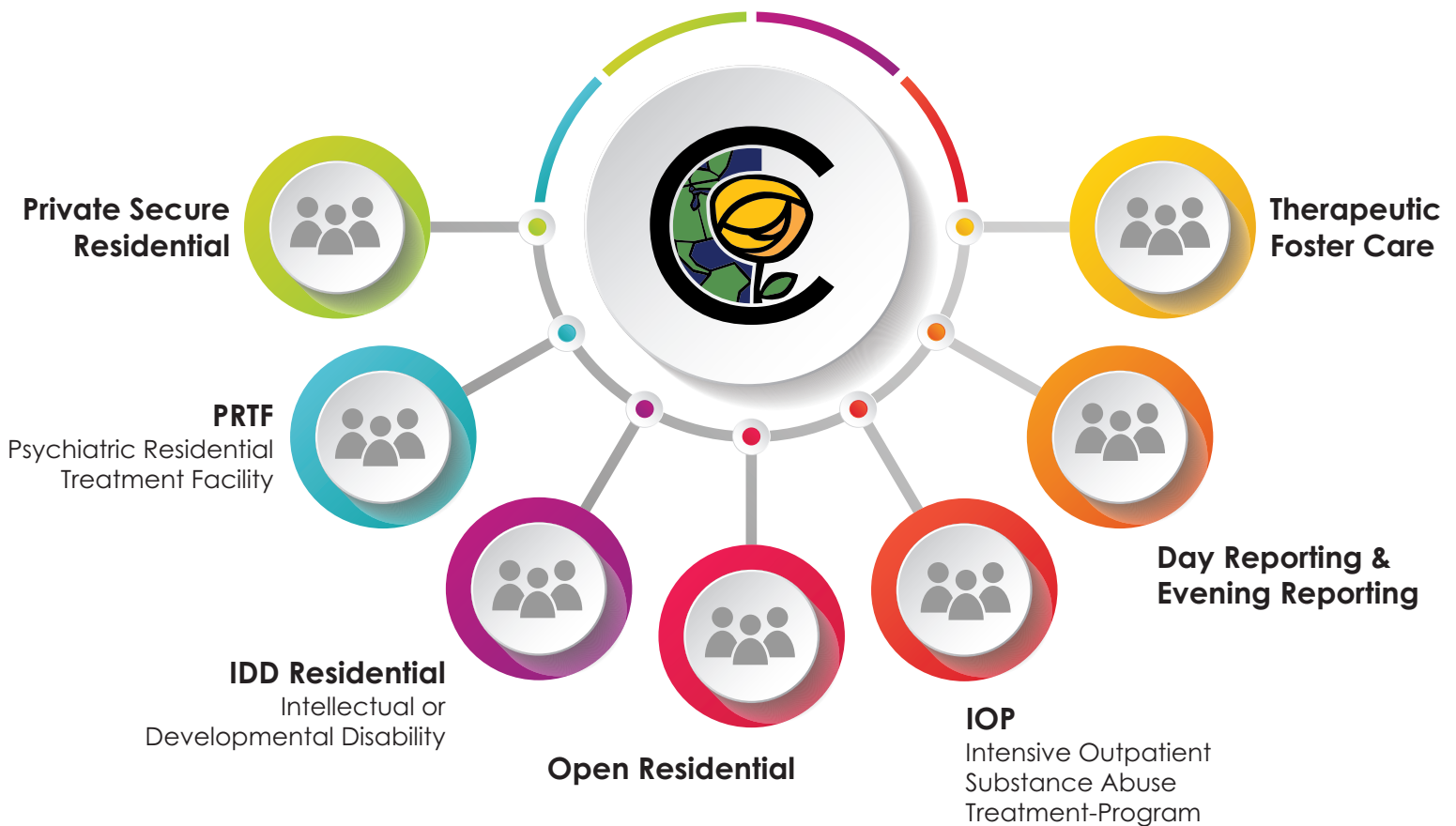

# My Future Looks Bright Thanks To Campagna



“On April 14, 2017, I was a 15-year old kid with tiny glasses, and a short five foot 11 inches, with a back injury after a suicide attempt. I had no hope, no faith, no love until I walked inside 1 East at Campagna Academy. I lived at the Hope Center for six months, worked through all four phases of the Private Secure Residential Program. While at Campagna I was working with a therapist named Ms. Megan and lots of caring staff.

Since my stay in 2017, I have not been back in any more residential facilities, I have not been suicidal in three years. It took a long time to get in a stable position. I was and I am improving my behaviors every day. I had some bumps that needed fixing but I can now be smooth sailing. I am working with a therapist at Centerstone and I am continuing therapeutic outpatient treatment.

I was a Senior at Bloomington High School South in Bloomington, IN before graduating early in February 2020. I am going to Vincennes University in the fall of 2020 and

will be striving for a broadcast/journalism associates degree. I plan to transfer to Indiana University to earn my bachelor's degree in Media and Communications.

I am currently a Certified Public Address Announcer with the NASPAA and have worked boys basketball, softball, and track & field events at Bloomington High School South.

I received an award from the MCCSC Math and Science Department this year and have received a \$500 scholarship that will help me in the fall.

From the bottom of my heart, thank you all for making me a better man. My family and I put in the work and drive to keep on moving towards a better future. To all of my staff on 1 East and everyone who supported me along the way I made it!

I am thankful for Campagna for saving my life and making me grow up. I learned that life has an expiration date, I need to drink that milk while it lasts”.

100%

In 2019 we had a 100% graduation rate in our IOP, Intensive Outpatient Program for Substance Abuse Treatment. Twenty-nine clients graduated from the program. They received the support from Campagna to lay the foundation for a functional life free from substances and equipped with the tools to manage their addiction. Our graduates also learned coping skills, social skills, and they developed a healthy sense of self-esteem through use of evidence-based practices. *\*IOP QA 2019 Data*

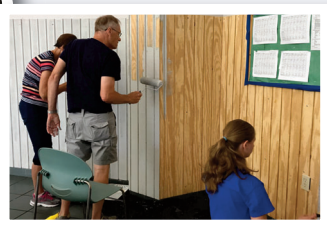

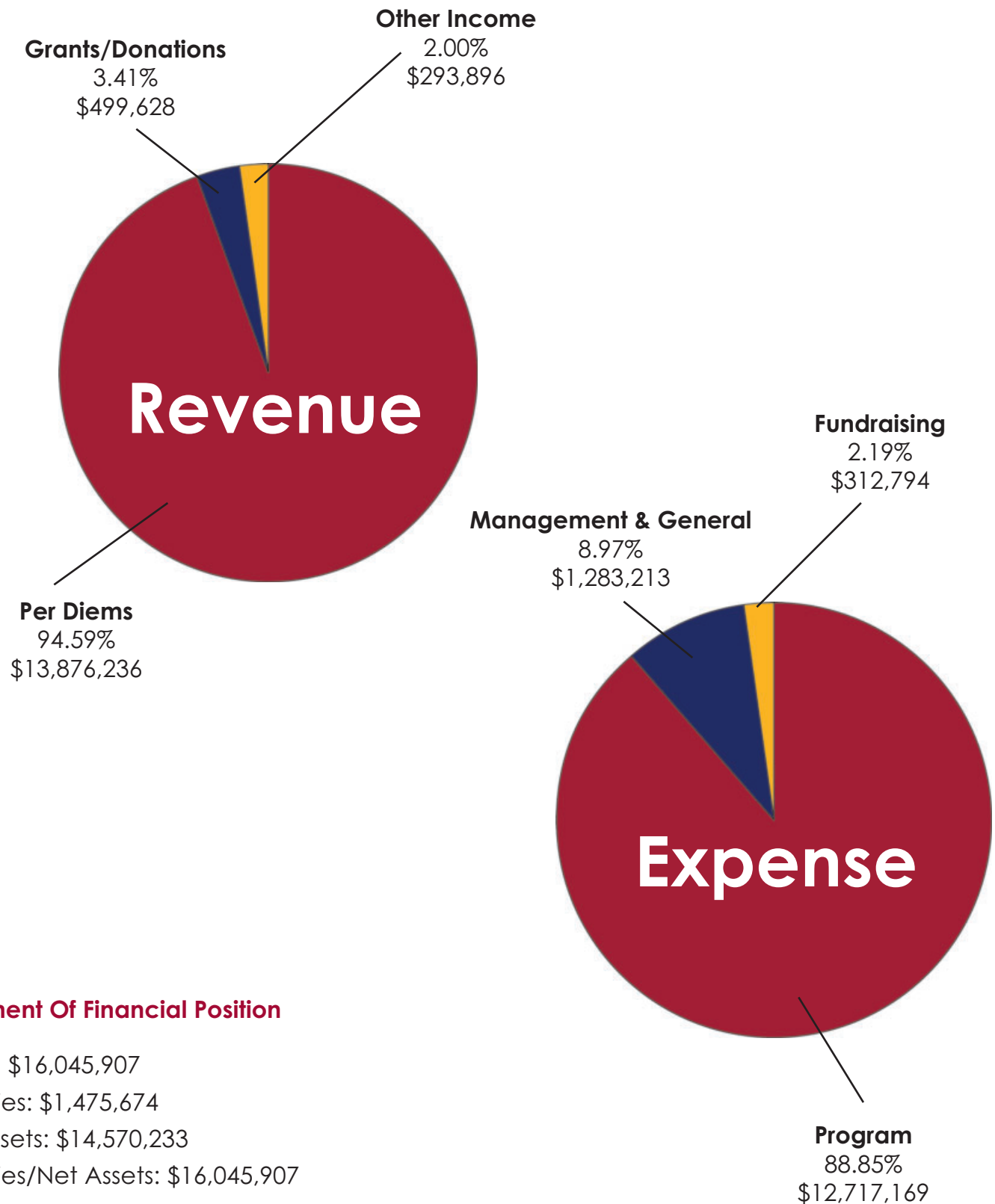

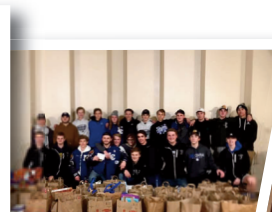
