

Abigale Baxter is a Youth Care Specialist in our Private Secure Residential Treatment Program. Abigale first came to Campagna Academy when she was 17 years old and was a resident of the program that she works in today.

What program were you in and how long did you stay? My stay was about six months long. I was in the Oasis Program on 2 West. I successfully completed the program and I graduated High School. When I left Campagna Academy I went directly into college at Purdue Northwest.

What was your journey like while at Campagna? My journey was interesting for sure. I had great staff. When I have structure I excel emotionally, mentally, and physically. I loved being at Campagna and seeing the person I could become with the right amount of stability and of course therapy.

In what way did Campagna make an impact on your life?

Campagna saved me. I don't like thinking about where I would've been without it. I wouldn't be here today. Campagna gave me the stability, structure, and support that I had never had.

How did Campagna Academy Restore your Hopes and Build your Dreams? Like other children that come from abusive homes I had extremely low self-esteem. I thought that I could never be more than homeless and mentally ill. Campagna gave me self-esteem and along with that came hope for the future again. Honestly, Campagna is still currently building my dreams. I get to help kids who need it the most.

What brought you back to Campagna? I wanted to give back. Regardless of our kids past, we as staff are giving them an opportunity for a brighter future. If I can help our kids by making this difficult part of their lives a little bit better, it is worth it.

Anything you would like to share with Campagna Academy's supporters? Thank you all so much for everything you do. Campagna gives great opportunities that most of our kids would never have. It honestly saves lives. You're a big part of it. We need people like you to continue to donate, volunteer and support our kids. I wouldn't be the person I am today without Campagna. I am forever grateful to Campagna Academy.



